- **81%** of the FLU GOLD collaborators also collaborate on the RSV GOLD project


COLOFON

OVERVIEW

In the past four months we received a total of 32 cases!

The following five WHO regions are represented among the cases: African region (18%), region of the Americas (25%), European region (36%), Eastern Mediterranean region (13%) and Western Pacific region (9%).



FLU GOLD inclusions per quarter

We received the most cases from Ecuador (14%), United Kingdom (13%), Kenya (9%) and Turkey (9%).

DATA ANALYSIS

Regarding our scheduled publication this year, we are closing the case submission for FLU GOLD. In the upcoming next months we will be reviewing and analyzing the data.
